To help get everyone into the Christmas spirit, the DOOLEYS Christmas Fair will return to Regent St Pavilion for a second year on Saturday 6 December from 11am to 8pm. This free full-day celebration is open to the entire community and will feature live entertainment, Christmas carols, free Santa photos, food trucks, market stalls, and much more. We would love to see you there!

It is also the season of giving, and I am delighted to announce the return of our annual Christmas Giving Tree Appeal in support of Parramatta Mission. With thanks to the support of members, DOOLEYS has continued to perform strongly this year despite a period of significant transformation. Our dedication to community engagement has also grown, with the DOOLEYS Board proudly reporting more than \$3.4 million invested in community initiatives over the last financial year. In addition, our staff contributed 275 volunteer hours through the DOOLEYS Helping Hands Program - meaningful progress on the year before.

Some of our key community contributions this year include:

• \$90,000 to the Women's Housing Company's Pathways Program.

- \$50,000 to Parramatta Mission's homelessness initiatives in Western Sydney.
- \$60,000 to St Vincent de Paul's programs in Western Sydney.
- \$35,000 to Barnardos, supporting families across Auburn and the wider Cumberland area with essential food relief.

I would also like to thank our members for their patience and support as we continue the exciting renovations at DOOLEYS Lidcombe. We understand the process has been lengthy and at times disruptive but significant progress is being made. These works represent a major transformation, positioning our club for the future with expanded facilities and enhanced member experiences. Some areas will reopen next year, with major facilities expected to be completed by the third quarter.

At our recent Annual General Meeting, the results of the 2025 Election of Directors were announced. Please join me in congratulating Anna Ryan, Tony Khoury and Helen Hughes on their appointment to the Board.

Hello Members,

As we approach the end of the year, I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your incredible patience and ongoing support as we continue the development works at Lidcombe.

Despite one of our most challenging and disruptive years, we are delighted to report another pleasing result, reflected in consistent performance and loyal member visitation.

We are now 17 months into what was originally a two-year building program, and realistically, we anticipate another 20 months before completion. We understand this has meant prolonged disruption, and we remain vigilant in minimising any building fatigue experienced by members. Member comfort, access, and safety will continue to be our highest priority as development works progress.

To enhance existing facilities, temporary improvements have been delivered including an enhanced sports viewing experience on the ground floor at Baileys Sports Bar. This addition helps offset the temporary reduction in operation of the John St Cafe seating area, which has been handed over to the builders. Behind the John St Cafe hoarding lines, significant demolition and structural works are underway to strengthen and connect between the old and new areas of the club. On completion, members will see no correlation between the old and new, as the flowing layout and full refurbishment will provide wonderful new facilities.

Members have also embraced the new Upper Cafe offering on Level 1, now our primary cafe destination. Its convenient location and connectivity to Lloyds Bistro improves accessibility and creates a centralised dining hub for all members during redevelopment.

While construction within the existing club has been complex and time-consuming, the new year will mark an exciting turning point. Members will soon begin to experience the delivery of new and long-awaited facilities. By the third quarter of next year, we anticipate handing back several major new areas. Your continued support throughout this journey is invaluable.

The expanded facilities will not only modernise our club but will enable us to offer a broader and more targeted range of experiences for all members. From stylish bars to diverse food offers and flexible event spaces, our new environment is designed to cater to the needs and aspirations of all.

Member feedback has played a vital role in guiding our planning, helping us to balance tradition while embracing new opportunities. Our focus remains on relevance and inclusivity, ensuring every member feels valued and welcome. We are excited to be creating an environment you will be proud to share with family and friends.

I would also like to acknowledge our dedicated staff, whose professionalism and adaptability have been exceptional throughout the redevelopment this year. Their efforts in maintaining high standards while operating in a dynamic environment has been outstanding and our point of difference.

CLUB CHAPLAIN'S Report REV EPELI QIMAQIMA, PARISH PRIEST, ST JOACHIM'S PARISH

Dear Friends,

On the 23rd of November 1945, Dr Takashi Nagai was invited to speak at the Requiem Mass celebrated among the ruins of the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception, Urakami, in Nagasaki City. He said, "On the morning of August 9th," an atomic bomb exploded above our district. In an instant, 8,000 Christians were called to God... At midnight that night, our cathedral suddenly caught fire and was consumed. At that very moment, at the imperial palace, His Majesty the emperor made known his decision... On August 15th, the imperial edict that put an end to the fighting was officially issued, and the whole world saw the light of peace. August 15th is also the great feast of the Assumption of Mary. It is not for nothing that the Urakami Cathedral was consecrated to Her... Is there not a deep connection between the annihilation of this Christian city and the end of the war? Was not Nagasaki the chosen victim, the spotless lamb, the holocaust offered on the altar of sacrifice, immolated for the sins of all the nations during the Second World War? ... Let us be grateful that Nagasaki was chosen for this holocaust! Let us be grateful, for through this sacrifice, peace has been given to the world, and religious freedom has been given to Japan."

Two thirds of the catholic faithful of Japan lived in Nagasaki and most of them lost their lives in such a cruel and inhumane way. Among those who survived was the famous physicist, Dr Takashi Nagai, who lived the rest of his years studying and writing on the effects of nuclear radiation. He worked tirelessly in memory of his wife whose remains he found where their home once stood two days after the atomic blast. Many refused to return to Urakami, North of Nagasaki City where the Cathedral was at the time of the atomic blast. But Dr Nagai, declared, "I want to be the first to live there!" So, despite his injuries from the blast, he built himself a shelter close to his former home—some sheet metal resting on a remnant of a wall. From the debris of his home, he found a crucifix from their family altar. "Everything has been taken from me," he said, "except this crucifix I found"

During those times of devastation Dr Nagai's faith and love for his people blew away the ashes of war, conflict and helplessness. Dr Nagai's commitment to serve his family and his people was a light that sparked hope and renewal in the hearts of many. To his children he said, "My dear children, love your neighbour as yourself. This is the word I leave you. It is by this word that I begin this document, and it is perhaps by it that I will end it, and again by it that I will sum it up."

It seems that war and terror keep returning under new labels. Some countries are still not at peace with each other. "Will humanity be happy in the atomic age, or miserable, asked Dr Nagai. "What shall we do with this double-edged sword hidden in the universe by God and now discovered by man? The decision rests in the free will of man. He holds his destiny in his hands. In thinking about it, one is struck with terror, and, for my part, I believe that a true religious spirit is the sole guarantee in this area... On our knees, in the ashes of the atomic desert, we pray that Urakami will be the last victim of the bomb (Dr Takashi Nagai)."

Like the Anzacs, we the people of Australia today, need to have cultivate the attitude of those Aussie 'diggers' who through toil and soil, never gave up on one another. We need to cultivate the same resilient stamina to build a society and culture where every man, woman, and child has dignity and freedom to practice their faith. Guns and bombs shatter and destroy lives. But harmful words slice the heart and shatters tranquillity of soul. The world is still along way from obtaining lasting peace. Let us start small by loving one another as Dr Nagai reminded his children. In this coming new year, "Seize the moments of happiness, love and be loved!... Here I am alive, and it's not my fault, so I have to try and get by as best I can without hurting anybody until death takes over (Leo Tolstoy: War and Peace)."

Q&A Spotlight with Kerry Fyfe, PTW **Director of Interiors**

Kerry is the creative force behind the design delivery of DOOLEYS Lidcombe redevelopment. Bringing an extensive 30+ years of industry experience to the project, Kerry has been the driving inspiration behind the design transformation and is deeply

involved in guiding the creative direction to ensure quality and integrity of the final result.

Q: What was the inspiration behind the new club design?

A: The inspiration comes from a variety of sources. The club is a complex space made up of many venues, so we treated each as a bespoke piece of design. The club's strong community base and its values of diversity and inclusivity were central. We aimed to weave these narratives throughout each space. For example, some areas are inspired by romantic journeys and places around the world - places you want to linger. The new cafe, for instance, is reminiscent of a Parisian cafe, while the bars have the feel of a grand international hotel.

Q: The entertainment lounge is a central hub. What should members look forward to in that space?

A: The entertainment lounge has been designed to be multi-functional and highly usable. It can operate a comprehensive variety of member activities during the day and transform into an entertainment venue at night. The design is more neutral to accommodate all these uses, with careful attention to noise and acoustics.

Q: How are the different levels connected in the new design?

A: Connectivity was a major focus. Previously, the connection between the ground and first floor was quite limited, so we have opened with new voids and staircases, ensuring a much better flow between spaces.

Q: Can you talk about the quality and luxury members should expect from the new finishes?

A: We have set our sights high in terms of quality and luxury, integrating traditional elements with a modern context. Members will notice beautiful materials like stone, timber, and brass, along with thoughtful detailing such as fluted wall panels, ribbed glass, and bullnose stone edges - elements that give each space a rich, elevated feel.

Q: How did you balance the local history of DOOLEYS with the push towards modern design?

A: That was a real challenge. We delved into DOOLEYS history to guide us, weaving those stories into the modern design. The external architecture, for example, echoes the streetscape through the use of articulated and glazed brickwork. Internally, historical details and quality materials continue this legacy, blending the past with the present.

Q: When members walk in, particularly from John Street, what first impression can they expect?

A: John Street will offer a completely transformed experience - open, voluminous, and filled with light. A feature staircase of shimmering gold, paired with dark timbers, creating a sense of luxury and drama right at the entry. The entire experience is elevated compared to the past.

Q: How does the design encourage socialising and relaxation among members?

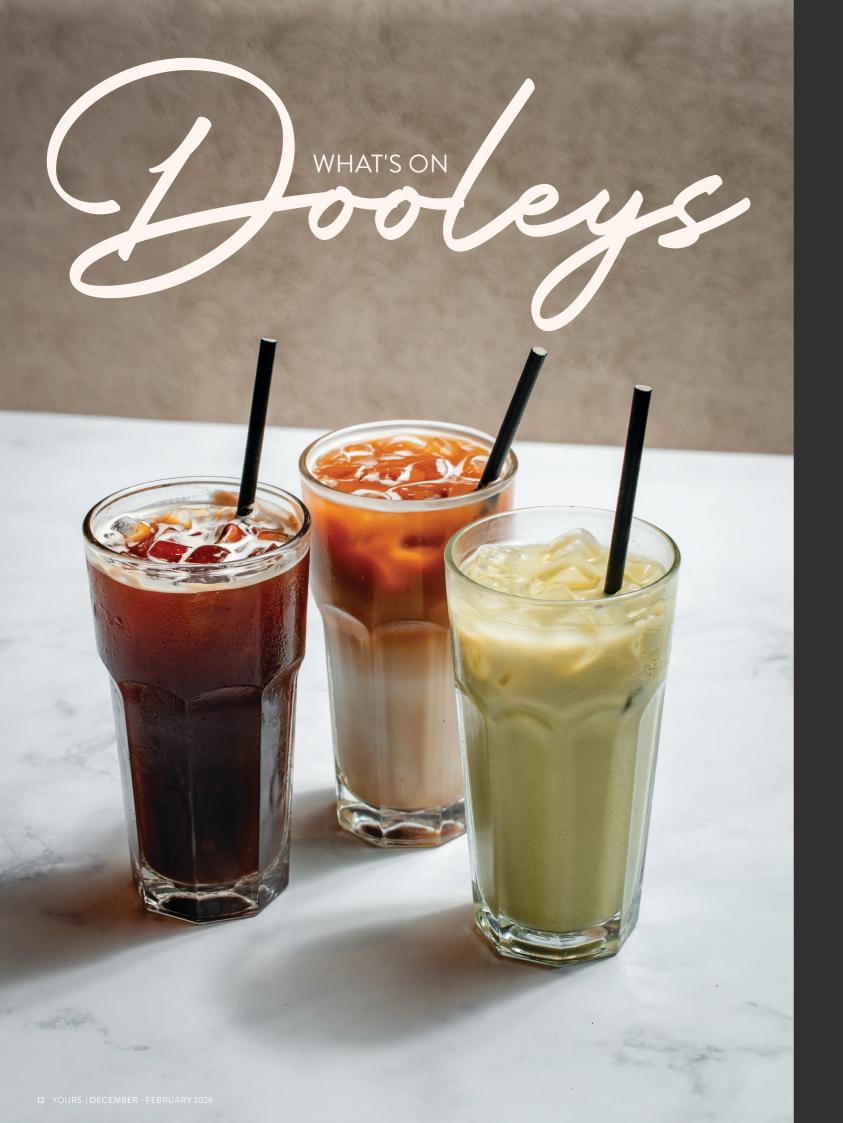

TO A WORLD OF REWARDS

HOW DO I JOIN THE DOOLEYS REWARDS PROGRAM?

All members are automatically welcomed into the DOOLEYS Rewards Program with an active membership. Participation is entirely voluntary, and members are welcome to opt-out at any time by notifying the club in writing.

HOW DO I EARN DOOLEYS REWARD POINTS?

DOOLEYS Reward Points are earned with every purchase made when your membership card is presented.

For example:

1 POINT earned for every
\$1 spent on food, beverage and reception.

1 POINT earned for every \$6 turnover on an Electronic Gaming Machine (EGM).

1 POINT earned for

every \$18 turnover on Multi Terminal Gaming Machines (MTGMs).

HOW MUCH ARE DOOLEYS REWARD POINTS WORTH?

1 POINT = \$0.01.

For example, 100 points = \$1 or 1,000 points = \$10.

HOW CAN I USE MY DOOLEYS REWARD POINTS?

Points can be used to make purchases within DOOLEYS venues on food and beverage, special events, gift cards, membership, wager exchange and more.

HOW DO I REACH A HIGHER REWARD TIER?

Tiering is determined by points earned over a rolling 12-month period. Every month eligible members are moved up a tier if they have successfully met the required accrued points over the previous 12 months.

CAN I GO DOWN A TIER?
