Dear Friends,

The audience could not contain their moves and grooves as UB40's Ali Campbell sang those famous words, "Red, Red Wine! I had the fantastic experience of attending the UB40 concert at the State Theatre on the 22nd of January this year. Seated next to me was a young father who brought his 8 year old son along with him probably to expose his son to world class musicianship. The thrill of being there was simply awesome. I realised that the music I was hearing was like a time capsule.

As the music played on, fond memories my childhood, the cousins, the family and village celebrations began flooding through my memory. It was totally out of this world. The crowd lifted the roof as we sang along with singer and songwriter Ali Campbell who knew how to entertain the crowd and fill the stage with his presence. It was a night to remember.

As I drove out of the busy Sydney CBD, a reminder of the world and society we now live in displayed itself unexpectedly. As I happily basked in the joy of hearing Ali Campbell live, police sirens suddenly screeched through my happy thoughts. Instead of the choreographed stage lights, a different kind of lighting began bouncing off the windows of shops and office blocks as an entourage of 6 black SWAT vehicles raced passed motorists and along the ANZAC bridge. The flickering 'read and blue' could be seen from afar as the SWAT team raced ahead. How quickly can such beautiful memories as attending a UB40 concert be taken away by the realities of life's journey?

Times of good cheer can easily be replaced by choices made through hate and conflict. The horror of the massacre of Australian civilians at a Jewish Religious Festival in Bondi is a stark reminder of the fragile world will live in. Music as form art also expresses human culture. That encounter with an entourage of the Sydney SWAT team reminded me of the lyrics of UB40's song timeless song called "Securing the Peace."

It reads, *"In peacetime sons bury their fathers
In war fathers bury their sons
The dead are all labelled as martyrs
And the living inherit the bullet and the gun."*

The British author Clive Staples Lewis (C.S Lewis) once said, "in heaven, there is always music and silence." There is a unique kind of silence that is present inside a church. It is not simply the absence of sound or noise. This peace is the presence of God who speaks through silence. It is a silence that allows the heart to bask in God's peaceful presence. As your Chaplain, I want to remind you all that, St Joachim's Catholic Church is open to everyone every day throughout the year. In our contemporary society, we are surrounded by noise, and we make little time for some peace and quiet. Should you wish to find some peace and quiet, or when you are feeling down, I want to invite you to drop in at St Joachim's Church on John Street which is an oasis of tranquillity and serenity. The church is the house of God and the palace of the poor.

As the year 2026 begins to unfold before our feet, let us be grateful for the country we live in. Australia is our home and as members of this large family, we are impelled to cultivate peace and respect. Temporary Reception at Church Street



Closure of Jade Room

As the Infinity Room on level 1 launches, we will be handing over further sections of ground floor facilities to the builders around April. This closure is a necessary step in our journey to upgrade and modernise facilities.

Our diverse destinations will celebrate global flavours while resonating with local tastes, informed by member feedback and contemporary dining habits. Each destination will have its own unique character and menu whether you are seeking a casual meal with family or a lively spot to watch a big game, you will find a new space that will suit your occasion.

Welcome

TO A WORLD OF REWARDS

HOW DO I JOIN THE DOOLEYS REWARDS PROGRAM?

All members are automatically welcomed into the DOOLEYS Rewards Program with an active membership. Participation is entirely voluntary, and members are welcome to opt-out at any time by notifying the club in writing.

HOW DO I EARN DOOLEYS REWARD POINTS?

DOOLEYS Reward Points are earned with every purchase made when your membership card is presented.

For example:

1 POINT earned for every \$1 spent on food, beverage and reception.

1 POINT earned for every \$6 turnover on an Electronic Gaming Machine (EGM).

1 POINT earned for every \$18 turnover on Multi Terminal Gaming Machines (MTGMs).

HOW MUCH ARE DOOLEYS REWARD POINTS WORTH?

1 POINT = \$0.01.

For example, 100 points = \$1
or 1,000 points = \$10.

HOW CAN I USE MY DOOLEYS REWARD POINTS?

Points can be used to make purchases within DOOLEYS venues on food and beverage, special events, gift cards, membership, wager exchange and more.

HOW DO I REACH A HIGHER REWARD TIER?

Tiering is determined by points earned over a rolling 12-month period. Every month eligible members are moved up a tier if they have successfully met the required accrued points over the previous 12 months.

CAN I GO DOWN A TIER?
